

CAA SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTIONS: 1 APRIL 2022 TO 31 MARCH 2023

GILES DUMPER	Giles Dumper held a Commercial Pilot's Licence, Flight Instructor and Flight Examiner certificates. As part of an assessment with a CAA-approved Senior Examiner, he produced his licence document. The Examiner observed discrepancies in Certificate of Revalidation entries and alerted the CAA. Giles Dumper then produced a licence document to a CAA Staff Flight Examiner, who found more discrepancies. In the course of the CAA investigation, Giles Dumper produced a licence document comprising different elements previously provided to the Examiners. He also produced his log book, which contained entries to support the Certificates of Revalidation. Certificates of Revalidation had been forged and entries in his log book were false. Giles Dumper had not in fact revalidated type ratings and therefore had been flying without an appropriate licence. Giles Dumper pleaded guilty to 4 offences of forgery, 3 offences of using a false instrument, 3 offences of making false entries and 4 offences of flying without an appropriate licence on 78 flights.	05/04/2022	Lewes Crown Court	20 months' imprisonment, suspended for 24 months.
