General Exemption E 4319

Occupational Health Medical Practitioners – MED.D.040

- 1) The Civil Aviation Authority, in exercise of its powers under article 266 of the Air Navigation Order 2016, exempts any doctor from the requirement under article 165 of the Order that in order to practise as an occupational health medical practitioner under MED.D.040 in the United Kingdom the doctor must be listed in the Specialist Register of the General Medical Council as having specialist registration in occupational medicine, subject to the conditions in Paragraph 2.
- 2) The doctor must:
 - a) be a Member or Associate of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine of the Royal College of Physicians; or
 - b) hold the Diploma in Occupational Medicine from the Faculty of Occupational Medicine of the Royal College of Physicians; or
 - c) hold an alternative occupational medical qualification which is acceptable to the CAA.
- 3) This exemption has effect from the date it is signed until revoked.

Explanatory Note:

This exemption permits a doctor who holds one of the qualifications mentioned in Paragraph 2 to act as an occupational health medical practitioner for the purposes of MED.D.040(b) in the UK, notwithstanding the doctor is not listed in the Specialist Register of the General Medical Council as having specialist registration in occupational medicine.
