INTRODUCTION OF FLIGHT CREW TRAINING NOTICES

- 1 Historically, Training Standards have sent information to instructors and examiners through a series of newsletters. Whilst this medium can be useful, and indeed will continue to be used, it is considered that some of these newsletter items needed a more formal location. Therefore, Flight Crew Training Notices (FCTNs) have been introduced.
- 2 The FCTNs will be web-based, similar to FODCOMs, and will be used to disseminate information to SFI/TRIs, SFE/TREs and Training Management on a range of topical safety related items. The FCTNs will also be used to identify relevant changes to legislation, as well as to Standards Documents. Notification of changes to any such controlled documents outside their normal amendment cycle will allow a more timely adoption of these changes. Instructors and examiners are encouraged to refer to these FCTNs for guidance and information.
- 3 The FCTNs will be published in the **Flight Operations** and **Flight Crew Licensing** areas of the CAA Publications website. The FCTNs can be accessed directly by the shortcut www.caa.co.uk/fctn.
- 4 Interested parties, who have not already done so, should register with CAA Publications in order to receive notification of new FCTNs as they are issued. To receive notification of FCTNs interested parties should subscribe to at least one of the following publication categories:
 - Flight Crew Licensing.
 - Flight Operations.

- 6 It is anticipated that FCTNs will remain current for at least six months at which point they will be assessed as to their continued applicability.
