To Shetland Space Centre Limited (a company with registration number SC575537 "("the Licensee"))".

1. Terms of Licence

- 1.1. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Space Industry Act 2018 and the Space Industry Regulations 2021, the Civil Aviation Authority ("the Regulator") GRANTS the Licensee a licence to carry out the Licensed Activities subject to the terms and conditions contained within this Licence.
- 1.2. The Licence is granted on the date stated at the head of this Licence.
- 1.3. The Licensed Activities are the provision of range control services as set out in section 6(1)(a) to (f) of the Act in respect of the conduct of launches from SaxaVord Spaceport.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1. In this Licence:
 - 2.1.1 "Act" means the Space Industry Act 2018;
 - 2.1.2 "Enters administration" has the same meaning as in paragraph 1(2)(b) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986;
 - 2.1.3 "Goes into liquidation" and "insolvency" have the same meanings as in section 247 of the Insolvency Act 1986;
 - 2.1.4 "Licence" means this licence;
 - 2.1.5 "Licensed Activities" means the provision of range control services, as defined at clause 1.3 above;
 - 2.1.6 "Reporting Plan" means the information, reporting and notification requirements as set by the Regulator in relation to the Licensed Activities, as attached and provided to the Licensee and as may be amended or updated by the Regulator from time to time;
 - 2.1.7 "Regulations" means the Space Industry Regulations 2021 and references to a Regulation in the Licence are to be construed accordingly unless otherwise specified;
 - 2.1.8 "SaxaVord Spaceport"¹ means the licensed spaceport situated at Unst, Shetland, Scotland.
- 2.2. Except where the terms are defined in the Licence or the context otherwise requires, the words and expressions used in this Licence have the same meaning as they have in the Act or the Regulations.

2.3. The Interpretation Act 1978 applies to the Licence as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. General Conditions

- 3.1. The Licensee must comply with the requirements set out within the Reporting Plan.
- 3.2. The Licensee must afford all reasonable assistance, co-operation and compliance as may be requested or required by the Regulator in the exercise of the Regulator's functions under the Licence, the Act or the Regulations.

4. Termination, Revocation, Variation and Suspension Terms

- 4.1. Without prejudice to its powers under section 15 of the Act, the Regulator may revoke, vary or suspend the Licence (including any conditions attached to the Licence) where it appears to the Regulator:
 - 4.1.1 there has been any material change in any of the information provided to the Regulator by or on behalf of the Licensee, whether in or with the application for the Licence or after the Licence has been granted;
 - 4.1.2 the Licensee enters administration or goes into insolvency or liquidation; or
 - 4.1.3 the Licensee has breached a condition of this Licence.
