# Replacement of ORS 4 Nos. 1576 & 1577

#### 1 Introduction

1.1 The purpose of this Supplementary Instruction (SI) is to update references to Official Record Series (ORS) 4 Nos. 1576 and 1577 within the Manual of Air Traffic Services (MATS) Part 1 (CAP 493) to ORS 4 Nos. 1603 and 1604 respectively.

#### 2 Background

- 2.1 ORS 4 No. 1576 entitled 'Standardised European Rules of the Air Issuing VFR and SVFR Air Traffic Control Clearances to Helicopter Operations Conducted by Police, Helicopter Emergency Medical Services (HEMS) and Search and Rescue (SAR) Operations' has been superseded by ORS 4 No. 1603. ORS 4 No. 1603 does not introduce any change to procedures detailed within MATS Part 1.
- 2.2 ORS 4 No. 1577 entitled 'Standardised European Rules of the Air Issuing VFR and SVFR Air Traffic Control Clearances to Helicopter Operations Conducted in Support of the Maintenance of the National Infrastructure' has been superseded by ORS 4 No. 1604. ORS 4 No. 1604 does not introduce any change to procedures detailed within MATS Part 1.

#### 3 Amendment to CAP 493

- 3.1 With effect from 9 August 2024 MATS Part 1 references to ORS 4 No. 1576 and 1577 are replaced with references to ORS 4 No. 1603 and 1604 respectively at the following locations:
  - (i) Section 1, Chapter 2, Paragraph 4.1, Notes 4 and 5;
  - (ii) Section 1, Chapter 2, Paragraph 8B.2, Notes 3 and 4;
  - (iii) Section 2, Chapter 1, Paragraph 6A.2, Notes 2 and 3; and
  - (iv) Section 3, Chapter 1, Paragraph 8.6, Notes 2 and 3.
- 3.2 This change will be incorporated into CAP 493 at the next amendment.
